Participants: Any high school student who is enrolled in a Chinese program in Georgia

Levels: There are two levels in this competition. Students should select

the level according to the number of years they have studied Chinese:

Level 1 is for students who have studied Chinese for 1-2 years.

Level 2 is for students who have studied Chinese for 2 years and above.

Competition format: the competition is divided into two parts, written part, and online part, 25 questions each. The written part will have short answer questions while the online part will be a Kahoot quiz. Level 1 questions and answers will be written in English and Chinese while level 2 questions and answers will all be written in Chinese. All questions will be selected from the attached list of review questions.

Prizes: Certificates and prizes will be awarded to one first-place, two second-place, and three third-place winners.
